



HOME OF GOOD HOPE MARRIES MAMMADU!

THE CANADIAN REGISTERED CHARITY 'HOME OF GOOD HOPE' IS PARTNERING WITH MAMADU TRUST, A HIGHLY ACCLAIMED CHARITY IN NAMIBIA. DONORS WILL CONTINUE TO DONATE TO THE *HOME OF GOOD HOPE* IN ORDER TO RECEIVE A TAX RECEIPT.



Mammadu is a non-profit organization which takes care of all the basic daily needs of the children.

It supplies clean water, nutritious meals, personal hygiene, preschool and regular education, and spaces for play and sport. Children aged 3 to 14 that live in the surrounding impoverished neighbourhood attend the centre.

Mammadu is located on a half-acre plot in the [slums](#) of [Otjomuise](#), a township situated in the farthest outskirts of the capital city of Windhoek. The slums of Otjomuise consist mainly of sheet-metal shacks which are very hot during summer and freezing in winter. There is no running water, toilets or electricity.

EDUCATION

While public school is free in Namibia, Mammadu also supports the children's education. Two qualified teachers are employed; there are two study halls, one for the younger and one for the older children.



Separate indoor toilet facilities are available for boys and girls.



MAMMADU BUS - Children are picked up at home and transported to school, community activities and various medical/dental appointments.

OUTDOOR SPACES

- a playground fully equipped with swings etc.;
- a sports field consisting of pounded local clay soil;
- a small orchard and a greenhouse.



The half-acre plot of land owned by Mammadu is fully fenced. This allows the children a safe and secure area to play freely.

THE KITCHEN

There is a kitchen with two industrial stoves, a large refrigerator, freezer and a pantry for storing food supplies. Five hundred meals are served weekly. All bread is baked on site.



COMMUNITY CENTRE



The opportunity to engage in Craft activities was originally created for mothers or women in the children's families, but the circle has grown to include their friends and neighbours as well.

The women not only have an economic gain from the sale of the items but are also empowered and able to develop their creativity.
